The venue:

- Stage surface - Vinyl floor (permanently installed) No rake – Crossover upstage behind tabs & backstage dressing room
- Includes PA system and basic lighting equipment
- We require a 50/50 ticket allocation with Ticketmaster and Camden Fringe (with ticketing commission).
