The Chapel Playhouse is London's newest fringe theatre, located in King's Cross, and is thrilled to be joining the Camden Fringe 2019. Run by the team behind award-winning The Bread & Roses Theatre in Clapham, the newly founded Chapel Playhouse is located in the basement of the re-opened café-bar Bread & Roses @ The Chapel and programs theatre, cabaret, comedy and more.

The venue has a stage of 3x4 metres, set up in thrust (audience on three sides), lighting and sound systems* as well as toilet and dressing room facilities. Seating capacity is 60 as a standard or with optional cabaret style seating 40 to 50.

During the Camden Fringe we charge £60 to £90 per slot + 30% of ticket sales, which includes a technician. We offer the following slots which will include your get-in, tech, show and get-out, so the exact start time of your show can be determined by you within that frame. You must, however, be out of the space by the time agreed and it is currently not possible to book additional tech time in advance.

* Thursday nights work with a more basic set-up of only a small stage platform and one spotlight, so are best suited to stand-up comedy, podcast recordings, radio plays and the like. This does increase seating capacity to 70 though.
