Our comedy venue The Tap is a fantastic 40 - 50 seater comedy room, underneath The Taproom.

The Taproom has been a popular cask and gravity beer bar since 2012. Mid 2018 after the success of comedy at our sister venue (Aces and Eights) we launched new venue The Tap in the basement room. Over the past 6 months the venue has played host to a variety of different comedy shows and welcomed some fantastic names to perform with us.

The space is a rectangular end on space, with a simple and distressed look. There are 40 folding chairs along with stools which can be set up in rows or arraigned in cabaret seating with a few tables.

It is set up with a simple sound system, stage lights and a projector. There is also a small but beautiful greenroom to the side of the stage.

Acts performing at The Taproom will need to provide their own technician and front of house as standard, but we are happy to help put you in touch with people where possible.

The Taproom is available throughout the Camden Fringe, from the 29th July - 25th August. Use of the space is free of charge, but you will need to provide a refundable deposit of £50 per performance (up to a maximum of £200) to secure your slots.

The venue is most suitable for comedy but we are open to programming simple theatre shows.
